AN AMAZING EXPERIENCE FROM THE ANIMAL WORLD

Roaming about in a forest once, a traveler suddenly saw a sparrow crying repeatedly and flying in and out of its nest on a tree. This scene astonished him and attracted his deep attention. What he saw also was a snake creeping up the tree towards that nest. At the same time he also saw that sparrow plucking leaves from the tree and placing them around its nest. The snake was creeping up and up while the sparrow was busy swiftly covering its nest with those leaves. Having done that, it then flew away another tree.
