## Death Kept Waiting By The Name Of God

Prophet Muhammad (SAW) had migrated to Medina from Mecca. With his splendid character and the simple message of one God that he conveyed, Islam was spreading fast. But there were still some tribes and their leaders who had no true faith and so posed a big threat to the Prophet.
